Three students, one non teaching staff member and some older siblings and parents have tested positive to COVID this week. Cases seem to be on the rise. Students should be tested if symptomatic and I should still be informed if your Gol Gol school enrolled child tests positive. The current situation in relation to COVID-19 advice from the Department of Education is essentially that precaution around the first 4 weeks of schooling this term is in place. We will continue to operate the same as we have been this year as we continue to manage this situation. The Department have advised that masks are recommended for staff and students. Mask wearing is not compulsory for primary aged students. Masks are available in classrooms. In order to attend school students must be well. Students should undertake a RAT if they are COVID symptomatic. I appreciate the due diligence of our school community.

Attendance

Please note that the preferred mode of notification in relation to student absence is Skoolbag. In this way, the office staff who record absences are directly informed and can meet our policy requirements in completing this important task. It is understood that with parents having access to their child's teachers email that parents inform the teacher in that way, please copy in the school email golgol-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au as on occasion a teacher is not on site and the school is unaware of why a student is not in attendance. Teachers mark the roll each day, so they know who is at school and who is not. All absences must be explained either through Skoolbag or a note after the absence.

Always check for head lice at the first sign of itching. The article below is a good insight into the life cycle of head lice and how to treat them.








